Frequency of use Daily / As required.

1. PEOPLE AT RISK (instructors and visitors)

Up to 15 participants, plus leaders and/or instructors

2. HAZARDS (Anything with the potential to cause harm)

- a) Arrows, misuse, incorrect storage/carry
- b) Bows, misuse, incorrect storage/carry
- c) Wet/uneven/unclear ground
- d) Targets, insecure not maintained, incorrect collection of arrows
- e) Other site users, pedestrian traffic
- f) Incorrect number of participants
