

FRISBEE GOLF

RISK ASSESSMENT

Frequency of use Daily / AS REQUIRED

1. PEOPLE AT RISK (instructors and visitors)

Up to 15 participants, plus leaders and/or instructors

2. POTENTIAL HAZARDS (Anything with the potential to cause harm)

- a) Uneven, wet surfaces, overhanging branches, brambles etc
- b) Failure to maintain equipment, incorrect use of equipment
- c) Other site users/visitors

3. ASSESSMENT OF RISK

- a) Low

4. LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS

- a) Tell everyone to look out for branches, roots and other potential natural trip hazards. Check suitable footwear.
- b) Activity equipment checked pre start by activity leader. Participants asked not to throw frisbees at one another.
- c) Group leader to be aware of passing groups especially when Frisbee/(s) in motion.
