### RISK ASSESSMENT SHEET

Frequency of use                      Daily / AS REQUIRED

1. **PEOPLE AT RISK** (instructors, participants, and others on site)  
Up to 15 participants, plus leaders and/or instructors
2. **HAZARDS** (Anything with the potential to cause harm)
  - a) Incorrect/inappropriate handling and use of rifles
  - b) Inspecting, replacing targets
  - c) Other site users attempting to interact/distractions etc
  - d) Misuse/ incorrect storage of pellets
  - e) Poorly maintained shelter
  - f) Inappropriate behaviour by participants
3. **ASSESSMENT OF RISK**
  - a) Medium
  - b) Low

4. **LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS**
  - a) Instruct participants of the Do's and Don'ts's. Inspect rifles at beginning of each session, keep rifles forwards, keep TBI's in barrel until activity starts
  - b) Ensure participants have clear instruction on process, all rifles are safe and downed
  - c) Inspect fencing and ensure other site users are not within close proximity of range
  - d) Pellets under control of instructor at all times, kept in sealed containers, limit number issued
  - e) Inspect daily
  - f) Ensure leader and supervisory adults controls those participating (Good Discipline)
