# Frequency of use Daily / AS REQUIRED

1. **PEOPLE AT RISK** (instructors and visitors)

Up to 15 participants, plus leaders and/or instructors

### 2. HAZARDS (Anything with the potential to cause harm)

- a) Falling objects
- b) Inclement weather
- c) Unmanageable group size, lack of supervision
- d) Incorrect manual handling/lifting techniques. Impact with poles in transit
- e) Uneven, unmaintained surfaces

### 3. ASSESSMENT OF RISK

### 4. LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS

- a) Check and inspect that poles are securely fastened

- d) All large poles MUST be carried by a minimum of two capable people. Advise everyone to aware of those around them.
- e) Inspect site before starting, brief users of any issues etc
